ANNUAL REPORT (2011-2012)

Nirmiti Foundation is an NGO which is carrying out projects on Formal and Non formal education in region of Navi Mumbai slums and Raigad District with support of funders like Bombay Community Public Trust and Times of India.

The vision of NGO is to minimize **the impediments and to upscale the resources for children in their developmental age**. During the execution of projects it is gaining experience and support of community and networking from the various stakeholders. NF desires to fulfill the maximum needs of children and support to and by Stakeholders.

1. Times Foundation initiative

Nirmiti Foundation in collaboration with Times foundation fulfilled the dream to prepare the youth and women to stand in competition of world for employment by gaining the speaking soft skills of English which are required in market.

Objective of the projects were

- a. To teach English to dropout students and those who are looking for jobs in the area like sales, receptions Tourism etc.
- b. To prepare unemployed person for jobs by giving Spoken English Program me to and to promote him/her if they are already in jobs.

Duration of the Project:

Six months - May 2011 to October 2011

Total six modules thought by giving speaking practice and many interactive games student shared their experience with British Council and Times foundation.

18 students drop out from class for various reasons like inconvenient class time, far away from main road, college exams, household responsibilities.

11 students completed total duration of the course and also appeared for main exam. They liked the simple way of interactive sessions, games and teaching method.

2. E learning Program (BCPT)

The Bombay Community Public Trust, a Mumbai-city based community foundation, has therefore launched this e-teaching project, in association with Mukangan and Tata Interactive Systems This Project seeks to create not-for-profit, standardized, and *quality*, technology-based teaching aids which are custom-made to teach the Maharashtra Govt's prescribed course for English in the vernacular schools -- so that Children in these (urban and rural) schools get the same high quality of teaching as those who can afford expensive schools and tuitions.

Nirmiti Foundation by doing successful coordination with Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation initiated the same project in 64 Schools of NMMC. BCPT arranged training for teacher to facilitate and introduce the concept.



Duration: July 2011 to March 2012

All schools were provided with set of DVDs including the entire syllabus in animation texture.

During the entire the process were facilitate the coordinator and emphasized the significance of E teaching.

In the academic year end 18 schools were evaluated for the e-learning where there was seen improvement in children. Still there are technical problems for playing the CD as non availability of electricity and shortage of time to see the full success.
